His mind was only changed when he wound up on the inside of a _____. <b>(Answer: Fish)</b>	God gave the 10 commandments to the Israelites written on what? <b>(Answer: Stone Tablets)</b>	He was the good friend of a missionary named Paul. <b>(Answer: Luke)</b>
300	Joseph took care of this land during a famine. His brothers and dad eventually moved there too. But later the Israelites had to get out of there! <b>(Answer: Egypt)</b>	Name one book of the Bible named after a prophet. <b>(Any book of the prophets is acceptable. Some we've talked about are: Isaiah, Daniel, Joel)</b>	The Israelites had seen God's power, but when Moses was gone too long on Mt. Sinai, they thought he died & made this to worship instead of the one true God. <b>(Answer: Golden Calf)</b>	Name 3 commandments that help us know how we are to treat others. <b>(Multiple answers are acceptable)</b>	He didn't see the things he wrote about happen, but he talked to those who did. <b>(Answer: Luke)</b>
400	This is the name for the area of land promised to Abraham and where the Israelites settled. <b>(Answer: Canaan)</b>	This is the name for the first five books of the Bible. <b>(Answer: Pentateuch)</b>	You might think of fishing when you hear this word, but in Hebrew it means "house" or "dynasty." <b>(Answer: Bayt)</b>	Who went up the mountain to receive the 10 commandments? <b>(Answer: Moses)</b>	He wrote a Gospel and the book of Acts. <b>(Answer: Luke)</b>
500	This woman prayed to God for a child so hard the priest thought she was drunk. (Double points if you remember her son's name!) <b>(Answer: Hannah, Her son's name is Samuel)</b>	This book of the Bible is the second one named after Hannah's son, the guy who anointed David king of Israel. In it we hear the promise that someone from David's kingdom is going to rule forever! <b>(Answer: 2 Samuel)</b>	They were partners in life. Literally made from the same stuff. They also both chose to be like God knowing good and evil rather than trusting God. <b>(Answer: Adam and Eve)</b>	On what mountain were the 10 commandments given? <b>(Mt. Sinai)</b>	He wrote a lot about outcasts and God's love. He was a Gentile. He also might have been a former slave. <b>(Answer: Luke)</b>
